THE THIRD LETTER OF JOHN

{This is either a General Letter (or Epistle) or it is a genuine personal letter about church matters from the Elder or "πρεσβυτερος" to his friend Gaius. It was necessary to clarify something about the relationship to a missionary who was being resisted by an arrogant local church official named Diotrephes.}

INSCRIPTION

SALUTATION

<III John 1-4>

- 1 The Elder sends his greetings to dearly loved Gaius, <*A common Roman name. Five individuals in the New Testament have this name. The name means "commended.">* the person whom I truly love.
- ² Dearly beloved, I pray that you are prospering in everything and that you are in good (*or*, *robust*) health. I know that your soul prospers ³ [for] ¹ I am overjoyed that the brothers arrived and told me of your fidelity to the truth and how you are living with obedience to the true life. ⁴ There is no greater [joy] ² than to hear that my children are living in truth!

COOPERATION AND OPPOSITION

<III John 5-12>

- 5 Dear friend, you are acting in a faithful manner (or, are loyal) in everything you do for the believers (literally, brothers), especially when they are strangers. 6 They have testified in the presence of the Church about your love. You will do well to help them (or, Please help them) on their journey in a manner that befits those who are in God's service (or, worthy of God's service). 7 It is on behalf of that Name <i.e. Christ> that they have set out and it is their custom not to accept anything from the Gentiles. 8 Therefore we ought to have it as our duty to support such people in order that we might be fellow workers.
- ⁹ [I wrote] ³ something to the church. However, Diotrephes, *Known only from the unfavorable comment here. The name means "nurtured by Zeus".*> who loves to have the prominent place among them refuses to accept our suggestions (*or, listen to us*). ¹⁰ It is for this reason that, should I arrive, I will bring attention to his activities (*or, censure his actions*). He speaks maliciously as with false tales. But, not content with this, he, himself does not welcome believers (*literally, brothers*) and he hinders those who desire to do this *<i.e. welcome other believers*> and expels them from the congregation.
- 11 Dear friends, do not imitate what is evil but rather do good! The one who does good is a child of God. The evil-doer has not seen God. 12 Demetrius *One of eight persons in the New Testament with that name. The name means "belonging to Demeter". Demeter was the Greek goddess of agriculture.*> has a good reputation from everyone and alsofrom the truth itself.. We add

FINAL GREETINGS

<III John 13-15>

13 I have a great deal more to write to you but I prefer not to write (*literally, pen and ink*) it on paper (*or, papyrus*), 14 but rather I hope to visit you soon and then we will speak face to face. 15 Peace be with you. Our friends here send you greetings. Greet our friends there individually (*literally, by name*). [Amen.]⁴
